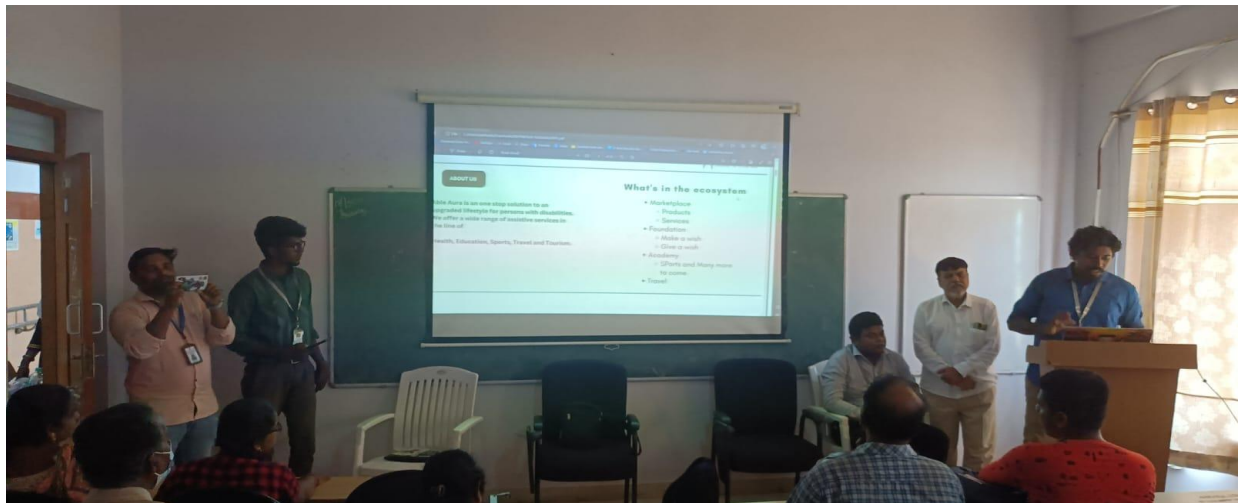
The Able Aura team explained about the importance of sports:
