1. Observance of World Braille Day:

NIEPMD observed World Braille Day on 4 January 2024 to commemorate the birth anniversary of Louis Braille - the inventor of Braille writing for blind and visually impaired people. Braille is a tactile representation of alphabets and numerical symbols using six dots to represent each letter and number and even musical mathematical and scientific symbols. This day aims to raise awareness about the challenges faced by individuals with visual impairment advocating for their rights and societal integration.

To mark the occasion, NIEPMD organised various programs in collaboration with St. Louis School for the Deaf and Blind at Adyar, Chennai. Dr. Innaci Raj, Principal, St. Louis School for Deaf and the Blind inaugurated the event and felicitated Smt. Leelavathi, Principal, Model School for Persons with Multiple Disabilities, NIEPMD. The events included Braille writing and Reading competition to empower individuals with Visual Impairment, Slogan competition and Fun games to engage Persons with Disabilities in a fun-filled environment, Poster competition for HRD students and Children with Special Needs to enhance their level of creativity. Around 100 participants were involved in the event of celebration of World Braille Day. Individuals with Visual Impairment, Persons with Disabilities, HRD Students, Faculties and Staff members were present among the occasion. Overall these activities encouraged an inclusive and accommodating environment for all.



2. Divya Kala Shakthi 2024:

National Institute for Empowerment of Persons with Multiple Disabilities (Divyangjan) (NIEPMD), Chennai in collaboration with Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities (Divyangjan), (DEPWD), Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, (MSJ&E), Govt. of India Organized the cultural event Divya Kala Shakti: witnessing the Abilities in Disabilities on 6th January 2024 at Ravindra Kala Kshethra, Bengaluru. It provides a wider and unique platform to showcase the potential of Persons with Differently Abled in the field of performing art, music, dance, acrobatics etc. About 75 (Karnataka -42, Tamil Nadu -17, Kerala - 9 and Pudhucerry -7) Children and youth with differently abled of various disabilities like Visual Impairment, Hearing Impairment, Locomotor Disabilities, Autism Spectrum Disorder, Intellectual disabilities, Multiple Disabilities etc from 4 South Region States have practiced over a month to display

their hidden talents. These artists performed dance, music, instrumental in classical, folk and modern style. This special event also includes Yoga and Acrobatics. Large number of women participants also took part in this event. More than 1000 footfalls including Persons with Differently Abled, Parents of Persons with Differently Abled, Special Teachers, Rehabilitation Professionals, Students NGOs, etc witnessed the program.

The Hon'ble Governor of Karnataka **Shri. Thaawar Chand Gehlot** inaugurated the regional cultural event by Lighting the Lamp in the presence of Hon'ble Minister **Shri. A. Narayanaswamy, Minister of State for Social Justice and Empowerment, Govt. of India** and Senior Officers of the Department from the State and Central Government.

The DEPwD, Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, Govt. of India in this direction has already organized two National events on 18th April and 23rd July 2019 respectively at President's house as well as Parliament Library Building, New Delhi with an objective to spread a wide awareness among all the four pillars of Democracy. More than 10 Divya Kala Shakthi Programs had been organized in various states. so that it can help in changing the role of society contribution towards Divyangjan. The DEPwD is committed to work in this direction for such kind of platforms through which Divyangjan can contribute for the socio-cultural and economic growth of the nation which is the vision of the Department. This program is funded under Awareness Generation Program (AGP) of Dept. of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities (Divyangjan), Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, Govt. of India.

Further, through the ADIP Scheme of DEPwD, MSJ&E, GoI 152 persons with disabilities have been provided with 152 Aids and Appliances worth for an amount of Rs. 12.69 Lakhs.

To mark the occasion a Press Conference on Divya Kala Shakthi was organized at Press Club of Bengaluru on 4th January 2024. Dr. Nachiketa Rout and Shri. Das Suryavanshi, State Commissioner of Persons with Disabilities, Govt. of Karnataka briefed about the Divya Kala Mela to the Print and Media Officials. About 20 Print and Electronic Media officials were present on the occasion.



3. International Purple Fest 2024:

The Office of the State Commissioner of Persons with Disabilities, Government of Goa, Directorate of Social Welfare, Government of Goa and Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities, Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, Government of India jointly organized the International Purple Fest 2024 at Goa from 8th – 13th January 2024. This Festival is the India's First-of-its-kind inclusive festival that celebrates persons with disabilities. The Inaugural ceremony of International Purple Fest 2024 was held on 8th January 2024. Shri.Pramod Savan, Hon'ble Chief Minister of Goa

inaugurated the program by Lighting of Lamp in the Presence of Shri.Ramdas Athawale, Hon'ble MoS, DEPwD,MSJ&E, GoI, and other dignitaries.

NIEPMD put up 2 stalls at the International Purple Fest 2024 from 8th – 13th January 2024. Among one of the stall, publications of NIEPMD were displayed. The NIEPMD service activities and various initiatives were briefed to the public in another stall. The Exclusive pavilion has been set up for Deafblind Experience Zone, where children from different schools were given some experience on performing activities under blind folded along with ear morphing to understand the difficulties of people with deafblindness and the need to learn the new way on communication-purely based on sense of touch along with the effective use of remaining senses.



4. Republic Day Celebration:

NIEPMD celebrated the 75th Republic Day of India on 26 January 2024 to mark the adoption of the constitution of India. The day remembers the struggle of our freedom fighters who sacrificed their lives and laid the foundation for sovereignty and secularism and it upholds the values of liberty, justice and equality.

To commemorate the occasion, NIEPMD organised three days program from 24th to 26th January 2024. Dr.Nachiketa Rout, Director, NIEPMD unfurled the Tricolor National Flag and delivered the Republic Day Address followed by parade performed by security staffs and Persons with disabilities.

During the Celebration, the series of events conducted are Drawing Competition for Persons with Disabilities under the theme of "India – A mother of Democracy" to develop their creative skills, Slogan Competition for HRD Students and Parents to strengthen our democratic and cultural values, Rangoli Competition for Parents of Persons with Disabilities, Quiz Competition for HRD Students and Parents to

share their knowledge about our mother country and various cultural activities including traditional dance, songs and traditional instrumental music are performed by Persons with Disabilities and HRD Students to showcase our National pride and cultural diversity.

Following the events, A book titled “Empowered Journeys – Chronicles from the DAIL Trainees”. was released by Director of NIEPMD. Around 300 participants including Children with Disabilities, Adult with Disabilities, HRD students & faculties and Security guards were involved in the event of celebration of Republic Day.

Overall, the celebration serves as a reminder of the rich nation's history, cultural heritage and understanding the role of each citizen's commitment to our country.

. To mark the occasion Department of Speech, Hearing and Communication, NIEPMD organized various programs from 3rd – 12th March 2024. The details of the program as follows.

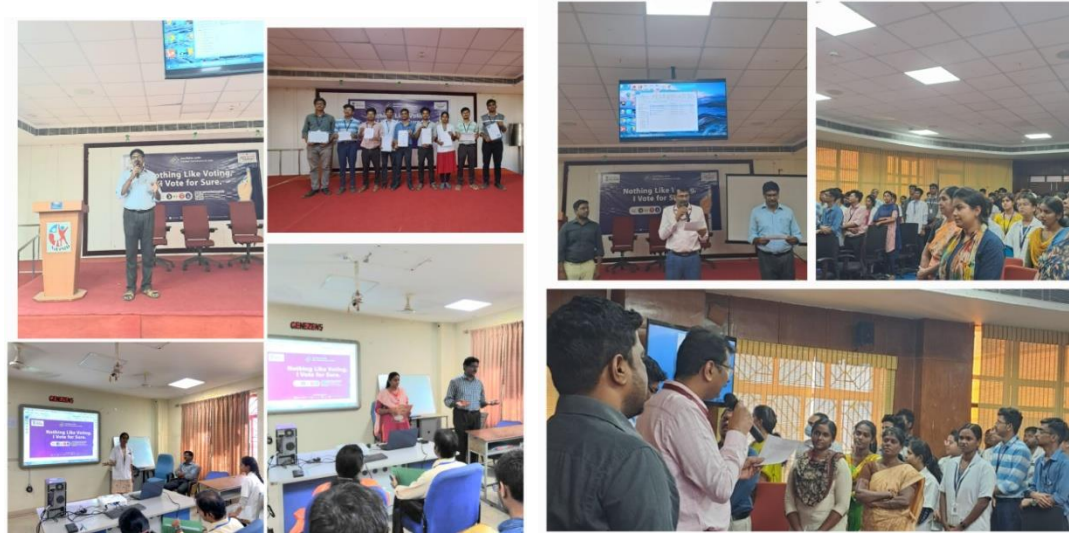
- An Awareness program organized at Chennai Airport on Sign Language

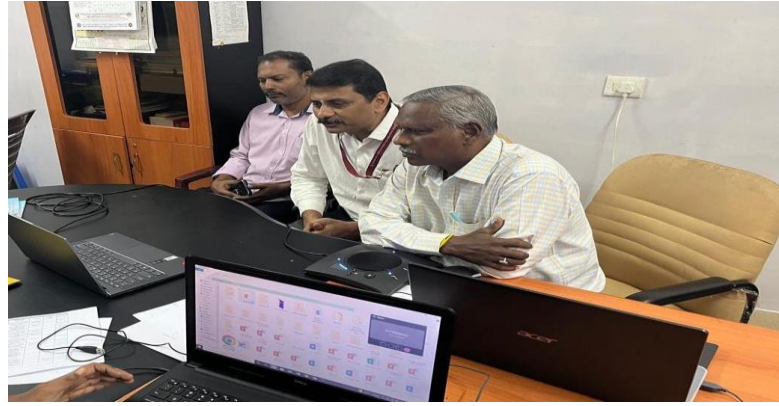
5. Executive Council Meeting of NIEPMD:

2. World Multiple Sclerosis Day:

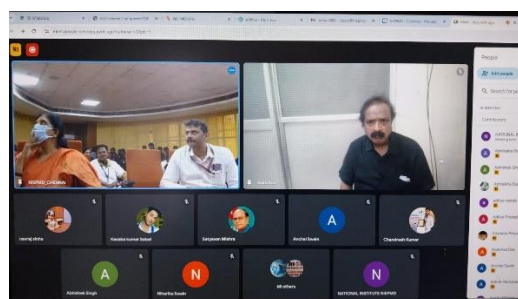

Events for the Month of June 2024

1. World Club Foot Day:

Every Year 3rd June is observed as " World Club Foot Day" in remembrance of Dr. Ignacio Ponseti who developed Ponseti Method to treat CTEV/Club Foot deformity in children & Ponseti International Association started observing it from year 2013. To create awareness among the rehabilitation professionals, parents and public, NIEPMD Chennai and AYJNISHD, MUMBAI observed this day by organising a webinar on 3rd June 2024. Dr. S P Das - Former Director SVNIRTAR CUTTACK and Orthopaedic Surgeon by profession was invited as Resource person to talk on "MANAGEMENT OF CLUB FOOT". DR. Das elaborately discussed various Consetvative and Non- conservative treatment approach to achieve near to normal Foot anatomy that improve the mobility, self image and active participation. According to Dr. Das up to 7years of age the deformity can be corrected under regular follow up and proper monitoring and success rate is nearly 85%. Dr.Das highlighted about the importance of parent Counselling and education about the treatment approach. Dr. Vijayalaxami- Pediatrician talked about various causes of CTEV. Dr. Nachiketa Rout, Director NIEPMD welcomed the Resource person and participants briefed out about the how Club foot deformity results in disabling condition and affect the individual's activities. About 105 participants belonging to various Medical and rehabilitation professionals, Trainees and Parents were participated.



2. Joint Secretary Visit:

Shri Rajeev Sharma, IFoS, Joint Secretary, DEPwD, MSJ&E, visited CRC Madurai on 7th June 2024 to review the service activities provided to Persons with Disabilities. 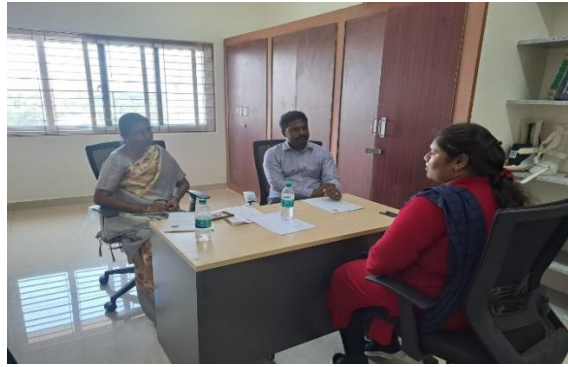
